

CONFINTEA consultations

On 22 July, WAVE joined civil society organisations (CSOs) from the Pacific to discuss recommendations for adult learning and education (ALE) in time for the CONFINTEA VII Pacific Sub-regional Consultation organised within the 24th Pacific Heads of Education Systems Meeting.

The event was co-organised by the Asia South Pacific Association for Basic and Adult Education (ASPBAE), University of Waikato Faculty of Maori and Indigenous Studies and Indigenous Maori and Pacific Adult Education Charitable Trust (IMPAECT).

It gathered 22 participants coming from Papua New Guinea, Solomon Islands, Vanuatu, Fiji, Tonga, Australia and New Zealand who discussed key issues and recommendations on adult learning and education (ALE) based on their country contexts. The rich discussions during the meeting brought forth a set of actionable recommendations, highlighting the good practices and perspectives from civil society organisations.

Proposed change of membership fees to be considered at AGM

The following proposal for change of membership fees will be considered at the AGM. This is to give more continuity of membership.

- Organisational membership - \$100 for initial joining and \$75 each year afterwards”
